#### Free School Meal Vouchers

Vouchers for children entitled to a free school meal will continue to be provided by **Edenred UK** who are working with the Department of Education (DFE). The site is still struggling to cope with the national demand, but we have been able to process orders by getting up very early in the morning and can see that vouchers are being redeemed. Vouchers will now be processed fortnightly to make it easier for parents. We have received lots of wonderful photos through eSchools, and we will be sharing some of these with you in the 'News and Events' tab on the school website to celebrate all that our families are enjoying doing together.

We will continue to add information to the Home Learning hub area of the website weekly, to keep you informed about ideas for learning for each year group. Please send a message through your child's eSchools page if you have any questions about learning at home. Teachers are checking messages daily, and will respond as quickly as they can.

One of the things which makes our school such a vibrant place to be are the whole-school events and experiences which we enjoy sharing together. We also really love our school trips, making things in DT, singing together in assembly and being active outdoors. To keep this going, a number of our teachers have set up group pages on eSchools, which have lots of creative and fun ideas to try. Children will receive a message from the teacher responsible for each group page to let them know when something new has been added to the page; they can access the group pages from 'My groups' on their eSchools page. They can reply to the message, so we can have wholeschool discussions with older and younger children working together. Groups set up so far are:

- Reading ideas (Ms Merriman and Mrs Dowdall) all about enjoying and celebrating reading
