When I start school on Thursday 3rd September 2026, I will be in Early Years in Class 1.

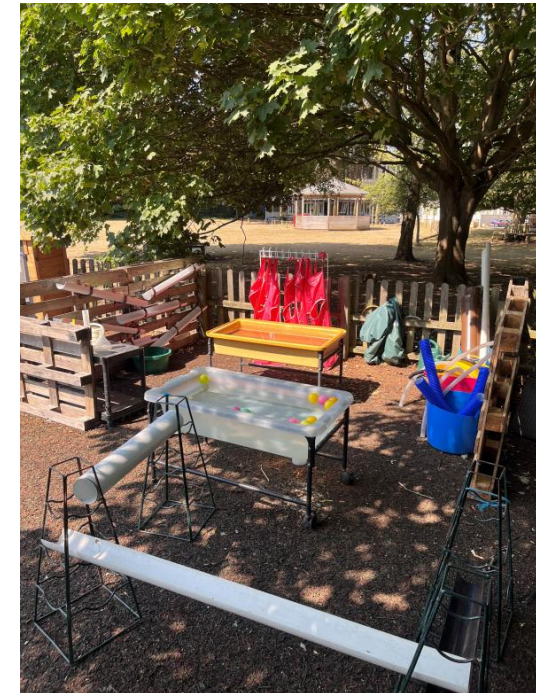
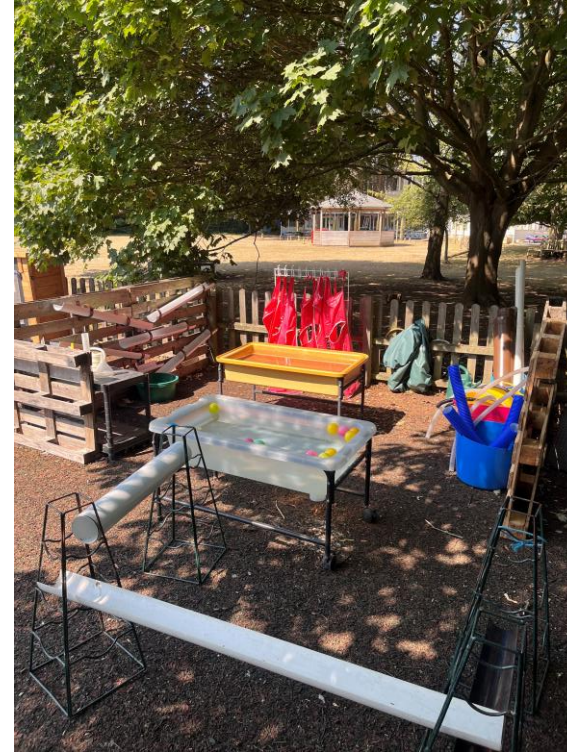


Miss Ozakpinar will be my teacher. She will help me learn.
