

Year 2 Half Termly Curriculum Information Letter – Autumn Term 1 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Year 2!

Reading

- Children will continue to have a free choice of book to borrow from our classroom book corner and can change this book as often as they would like.
- Your child will also bring home a 'Big Cat' levelled book, matched to their phonics level. This book will be changed once a week, on a Friday.

Please read these books together and record any comments in your child's reading diary, along with comments about any other reading your child has done at home. This could be books they have borrowed from school, a library or those which they already have at home. We will be trying to win the KS1 reading trophy, which will be awarded weekly to the KS1 class with the most recorded reading. Reading diaries will be checked on a Friday and we will be counting how many children have been able to record **at least five recorded home reads in a week**.

PE

Our PE lesson days are **Monday** and **Friday**.

Year 2 children will not need to bring a separate PE kit to school. Instead, they should come to school dressed appropriately for PE on Mondays and Fridays. This will reduce the need for children to change during the school day and help us make the most of our lesson time.

Friday's PE session will take place outdoors, so children should wear **suitable trainers** and clothing appropriate for the weather. Please ensure that earrings are removed on PE days and that long hair is tied back. Monday's PE session will be indoors.

General information

- Children will continue to be provided with a piece of fruit every day at morning break. Please feel free to send in another piece if you would like.
- Please ensure water bottles are clearly named and brought to school every day. These bottles should contain **water only**.
