Seesaw: New Home Learning Codes (login details)

We use Seesaw to make it easier for children to share learning beyond the classroom with their teachers. Seesaw offers a simple solution to sharing learning with the benefit that it also gives children access to a few simple tools to do so. As it would seem very likely that we go into the Spring Term with a continued need for children to have to self-isolate at times, we have decided to update the login details (Home Learning Code) for all children. Children will bring home a paper copy of their Home Learning Code today. We use Seesaw to make work available for children to access from home when they need to access remote learning.

Children in Year 1-6 have an existing login which will expire in February 2022, whilst children in Classes 1 and 2 have an existing login which will expire in September 2022. You can still use the existing login until that time, as well as the new one, although we would recommend switching to the new one to keep things simple!

If your child has not yet used Seesaw, please do try it out with them if you can. We have chosen Seesaw because:

- it makes sharing learning with school simple and quick to do
- it keeps all the shared work together in an online journal
- it gives the children access to many different ways to share their work
 - Photo – Send a picture of work through the camera on the device
 - Drawing – Draw on screen and share learning
 - Video – Make a short video through the device
 - Upload – Attach a file saved on a device
 - Note – Type into the note pad on screen and share
- It makes it quicker for teachers to add comments to a piece of learning

Getting started is simple. Please keep the individual login information safe.

- 1) For tablets or phones, download the **Seesaw Class App** (Make sure it is the 'Class' app)
For laptop or desktop computers, go to **app.seesaw.me**
- 2) Click **I'm a Student**
- 3) Enter the **text code** or **scan the QR code** (Using the information from school.)
