

### English:

- Reading, performing and writing poems about food.

- Grammar – adding suffixes, adverbs, apostrophes and identifying different sentence types.

Using online software to create pictograms.

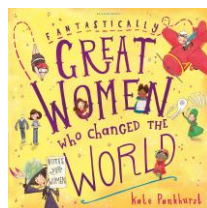
### PE:
