Maths tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Practise multiplication and division facts for the 6 x table.
- Create 5 word problems (using any of the four operations) for a family member to solve.
- Use the >, < and = symbols to compare the two numbers.
- Write as many questions as you can about the data table.
- Have a go at answering the 10 arithmetic questions as quickly and as accurately as possible.

Reading tasks

- Read out loud to someone you live with or someone on the phone / Skype / Zoom. It could even be to a toy or a pet!
- Make a poster advertising your favourite book.
 What makes it such a good read?
- Look at this week's reading ideas. Click 'Me' then 'My Groups'.
- Take an Accelerated Reader quiz once you have finished a book.
- Try to read for 30 minutes every day!

Spelling tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Practise 5 new spellings from the Year 3/4 spelling list using the 'look, say, cover, write, check' technique.
- Create 5 questions using a practised spelling in each.
- Pick one of the spellings and make other words using only the letters in the spelling.
- Write your own dictionary definition for each spelling.
- Create a word pyramid for each practised spelling. You could turn it into a piece of artwork and display it somewhere in your home.

Writing tasks (aim to do one a day)

- BBC Bitesize English lessons. You can watch them using the red button on your TV Monday-Friday.
- Sentence doctor can you fix these sentences?
- Answer the questions about the bear picture.
- Finish the story about the bears.
- Use the editing checklist to check your work.
