Spelling tasks (aim to do one a day)	Writing tasks (across the week)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Look at the BBC bitesize video about words that have the 'I' sound spelt with a 'y', such as pyramid.</li> <li>Use look, say, cover, write to practice spelling these words.</li> <li>Complete the word search of words that have the 'I' sound spelt as a 'y'.</li> <li>Take a look in your current reading book – can you find any words that have the 'i' sound spelt as a 'y'?</li> <li>Create a poster of words which use the 'I' sound spelt with a 'y'.</li> </ul>	<p>Class Text: Street Child</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write a thought bubble for Jim after listening to Chapter 13: The Lily.</li> <li>Listen to chapter 14 and 15, then use the punctuation for direct speech to write a conversation between Jim and another character.</li> <li>Listen to the next chapter. Use the BBC Bitesize link and then write a short play script.</li> <li>Listen to Chapter 17. Create a 'Role on the Wall' for the character of Grimy Nick. The next day, use this activity to help you write a detailed character description of Grimy Nick.</li> </ul>
