Provision Providing release for strategic leadership of sport.	Rationale School sport senior manager, PE Curriculum Leaders (KS1 and KS2) continue to work together to improve the overall quality of PE and school sports in our school.

	Leaders to attend the CSSP Network Meetings to maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of high quality PE. This will improve subject coordinator monitoring as well as the delivery of high quality PE in our school.
