

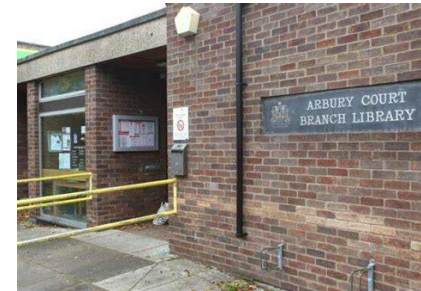
Spring 1 2022 – Home Learning Projects
