Remember to read the rules carefully!Complete the 'Tens and Ones' sheet by counting the ten sticks and ones.Try the 'Code Breaking' challenge.		<ul style="list-style-type: none">Listen to or read along with 'Dear Zoo' by Rod Campbell.Read the story 'Goodnight Gorilla', along with the video. Watch out for the gorilla's cheeky tricks!Read 'The Zoo Vet' on eSchools to, or with, a grown up and have a go at answering the questions.Look carefully at the map of Chester Zoo and decide your route through the zoo.Read the clues about zoo animals and match the sentences and pictures.

You might like to set up a hunt to find 5 of each tricky word around your house.Practise writing this week's tricky words, can you put them in a sentence?This week we're practising spelling words with double letters. Have a look at the activities on eSchools and choose one (or more!) to have a go at.		<ul style="list-style-type: none">Write a postcard to your family or teacher to tell them about your trip to Chester Zoo.Make your own zig zag book about different animals you saw at Chester Zoo. Can you draw pictures of the animals, and write descriptions of their appearance and any interesting facts that you learned about the animals?Write an 'Animal Alphabet', you might want to include animals you see while exploring Chester Zoo.The tortoise, giraffe and monkey letters have got all mixed up at the zoo! Can you sort them into their letter group?Use 'and' to join sentences about visiting the zoo together.
