Message from Mrs Rawlins – 1.7.22

It was great to see so many of you on the school field on Monday and Tuesday for our Y3/4 and EY/KS1 Sports events. The children had a lot of fun taking part in their races! Sadly, the Y5/6 event planned for today had to be cancelled due to the rain during the night, but we have rescheduled the event for 9am on Tuesday 5th July (rain permitting!). Also this week, Y2 children had a lovely trip to Hunstanton, and on Tuesday, it was so nice to welcome into school for Stay and Play, nearly all of the children who will be joining us in September, along with their parents and carers.

Summer reading challenge: We had a visit last week from Cambridgeshire library staff to let us know about the Summer Reading challenge for this year.
