## Order of the day:

11:30-13:00: a family art and craft workshop during which children will have the opportunity to make an animal mask that they can wear to perform in the play.

13:00-13:30: a dress rehearsal of the performance.

14:00-14:30: the performance. The children will star as Noah's animals, parading across the stage (guided by three workshop leaders) and into the ark! They will perform alongside student actors from the University of Cambridge in front of a live audience, which will include their parents / guardians.

14:30: handing out certificates, signing out and goodbyes.

## **Key information:**

This event is suitable for KS2 children (7-11 years).

As this is a family workshop, we ask that accompanying parents / guardians please remain with their children at all times.

Due to space limitations, we ask that children bring only one parent / guardian with them to the art and craft workshop. However, they can be joined by an additional parent / guardian for the performance itself at 14:00. Accompanying parents / guardians will be allocated a free ticket to watch the performance.

Biscuits and squash, teas and coffees will be available throughout the session. We ask that all participants could please bring a packed lunch along with them; there will be picnic tables outside for families to sit at and eat their lunch at any time during the arts and crafts workshop (11:30-13:00).
