**Contact Tracing over the School Holiday – Updated**

Dear Parents/Carers,

I have updated the information to account for the changes in isolation times from 14 days to 10.

After today, if your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, please use the main school office email account ([office@arbury.cambs.sch.uk](mailto:office@arbury.cambs.sch.uk)) to inform us. This account will be checked daily at 7.00am until 24<sup>th</sup> Dec 2020. With the vast majority of suspected cases in young children not resulting in a positive test result and to avoid unnecessary worry and confusion, we will no longer be notifying you of suspected cases after the end of the Autumn term.

Summary of Responses Following a Positive Covid-19 Test	
Date symptoms began (or date of positive test if asymptomatic)	Action Required
Up until Friday 18 <sup>th</sup> Dec	Parents/Carers should inform school immediately. The school will notify contacts within the bubble of the positive case. Notified individuals will have to self-isolate for 10 days.
Saturday 19 <sup>th</sup> Dec	Parents/Carers should inform school immediately by email. The school will notify contacts on Thursday 17 <sup>th</sup> and Friday 18 <sup>th</sup> within the bubble of the positive case. Notified individuals will have to self-isolate for 10 days.
Sunday 20 <sup>th</sup> Dec	Parents/Carers should inform school immediately by email. The school will notify contacts on Friday 18 <sup>th</sup> within the bubble of the positive case. Notified individuals will have to self-isolate for 10 days.
Monday 21 <sup>st</sup> Dec – Monday 4 <sup>th</sup> January	Unless testing was delayed following onset of symptoms, the case was not in the setting and therefore there is no need to contact school.
