Year 6 SATs – Special Consideration

As you are aware, the Year 6 SATs will be commencing on Monday 9th May. The children will be completing various assessments over the course of the week as detailed in the previous letter you received.

We would like to take this opportunity to let you know that the school can make an application for special consideration if a pupil's performance in a Key Stage 2 test has been affected by extremely distressing circumstances during test week or the weeks immediately before test week. This means that if your child qualifies, they could receive some additional points to their overall score. If you feel that your child may qualify for special consideration, please get in touch with Mrs Rawlins or Mr Tull by Monday 16th May at the latest.

Special consideration is only used in very unusual and extreme circumstances, for example, a bereavement involving a close family member or close friend or a traumatic incident that has occurred around the time of the assessments.
