Kingswood residential trip

As you will probably be aware, last Thursday, schools received Government guidance on reopening schools fully in September. Within the guidance, it stated that school trips involving residential stays would not be permitted. Consequently, we have had to cancel the Kingswood trip, and have made contact with Kingswood to withdraw our booking.

Being realistic, it is unlikely that it will be possible to rebook and run this residential trip later on in the school year, so we have made an application to Kingswood for a refund of the money paid. They will refund everything apart from the deposits, which are non-refundable. However, we will pick up the cost of the deposits, and will be able to give you a full refund for all that you have paid, in September, when we have had everything refunded to us by Kingswood.

It is a shame that the trip has had to be cancelled, but, of course, we must adhere to the guidance we have been given for the health and safety of everyone involved.
