Maths tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Think about the character of Willy and discuss his character with someone at home. You could use the prompts to help you.
- Make a poster advertising your favourite book. What makes it such a good read?
- How many different places can you find to read a story this week?

Spelling/ Grammar tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Practise spelling and using the homophones to/too/two and there/their/they're. (See eSchools).
- Practise using commas for lists. (See eSchools for resources and a game to play with your family).
- Practise spelling our 'Words of the Week'.
- Play spelling/grammar games in the homework area of Education City.

Writing tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Write sentences using the 'Words of the Week' or words from the spelling tasks.
- Look at the paragraph. How many errors can you spot and correct? (See eSchools).
- Write a book review. This could be for Willy the Wimp or a book of your choice.
- Write a character description for Willy from the story Willy the Wimp.

Other things to try out this week:

Theme: Seaside

- Look at the photographs of the seaside on eSchools. What can you see? Identify which are human and which are physical features.
- Draw/paint/collage/create a seaside scene. How many different features of the seaside can you include? Try to include some human and some physical features.
