We looked at ways we can learn from the photos and artefacts we have in school. Here is a class photo from the 1980s.




This was taken in the school car park in 1960. This car was used to bring a child from Histon to our

school.




This photo was taken in 1960 outside Class 9 on the school field. Now, there is a canopy outside the classroom and some huge trees.

until 1977.








This sports shield shows the first school logo of a knight on horseback.
