<b>Maths tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>	<b>Reading tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Watch the videos on the White Rose Maths website (Summer Term Week 8). <a href="https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/">https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/</a> Lesson 1: Count sides and vertices on 2D shapes. Lesson 2: Count faces, edges and vertices on 3D shapes. Lesson 3: Sorting 2D and 3D shapes. Lesson 4: Patterns with 2D and 3D shapes. (See eSchools for accompanying activity sheets).</li> <li>Have a go at answering the arithmetic questions on eSchools. Remember to draw things to help you!</li> <li>Play maths games in the homework area of Education City.</li> <li>Practise times tables on TT Rockstars. Aim for 5-10 minutes a day, if you can.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read a book or listen to a story (every day if you can).</li> <li>Think about a story you know well or are reading. If you could design a new character for the story, what would they be like? You might like to draw your new character.</li> <li>Have a go at the reading comprehension on eSchools about seahorses.</li> <li>Read the riddles. Can you work out which sea creature they describe?</li> <li>Look for our 'Words of the Week' or words from the spelling tasks in books or texts that you are reading. Make a list of all the words you find.</li> </ul>
<b>Spelling / Grammar tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>	<b>Writing tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Practise spelling our 'Words of the Week'.</li> <li>Practise spelling words which require a double consonant before adding 'ing' or 'ed' e.g. pat – patting – patted, hop – hopping – hopped. (See eSchools).</li> <li>Revise the uses of capital letters. Check the sentences on eSchools for the correct use of capital letters and explain when/why they are needed.</li> <li>Play spelling/grammar games in the homework area of Education City.</li> <li>Using only the letters from the word 'starfish', how many other words can you spell?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write sentences using the 'Words of the Week' or words from the spelling tasks.</li> <li>Look at the picture on eSchools of the person on the boat. Use your imagination to write a description of who the person could be, why they are on a boat and what they could be doing.</li> <li>Create an acrostic poem about the seaside. It could be about the beach or sea creatures. You could use the template on eSchools or make your own using a word related to the seaside.</li> <li>Write sentences to describe the sea creatures. Think about ways you could make your sentences exciting.</li> <li>Practise joining your handwriting using the sentences on eSchools.</li> </ul>
