<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Practise multiplication and division facts for the 4 x table.</li><li>Use the column method to solve the subtraction number sentences.</li><li>Solve the division word problems.</li><li>Can you make the given totals by using the numbers on the dartboard?</li><li>Have a go at answering the 10 arithmetic questions as quickly and as accurately as possible.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Read out loud to someone you live with or someone on the phone / Skype / Zoom. It could even be to a toy or a pet!</li><li>Design a new book cover for the book you are reading.</li><li>Read about William Shakespeare and complete the <a href="#">comprehension questions</a>.</li><li>Look at this week's reading ideas. Click 'Me' then 'My Groups'.</li><li>Try to read for 30 minutes every day! Take an Accelerated Reader quiz once you have finished your book.</li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Practise 5 new spellings from the Year 3/4 spelling list using the 'look, say, cover, write, check' technique.</li><li>Create 5 'silly' sentences using a practised spelling in each.</li><li>Create your own word search with the 5 spellings in.</li><li>Find out what each of your 5 practised spellings are in another language!</li><li>How many different words can you make from the letters in 'Accelerated Reader' (e.g. 'deer')?</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>BBC Bitesize English lessons. You can watch them using the red button on your TV Monday-Friday.</li><li>Sentence doctor – can you fix these <a href="#">sentences</a>?</li><li>Finish the <a href="#">story</a> about Macy and Judith.</li><li>Write thought bubbles for the girls in the <a href="#">picture</a>.</li><li>Create a word search for someone you live with using adverbs!</li></ul>
