Message from Mrs Rawlins – 5.3.21

You will have received Mr Tull's letter earlier this week with detailed information on arrangements for returning to school on Monday, and earlier today, I sent out year group letters to give you an overview of learning for the next 3 weeks. We are very happy to be open again to all children.

Remote learning

Thank you for the amazing support you have given children with learning at home, and for making excellent use of Seesaw. Teachers have really appreciated being able to respond to work submitted much more easily than through eSchools. From Monday, work for those children who are Clinically Extremely Vulnerable (CEV), self-isolating or quarantining will be set as activities on Seesaw, and not on the eSchools Daily Learning page. We will be able to support you as needed to access this work, and we should also be able to offer a device for a child to use if required.

Wellies!

Teachers have asked me to remind you that, if possible, it would be good for children in EYFS to Year 4 to have a pair of wellies in school at the moment. The field is still pretty wet, and we can maximise our use of the outdoors without shoes getting muddy if children have wellies in school.
