Message from Mrs Rawlins – 24.3.23

I hope that you have had a good week! We will be finishing next Friday for the Easter break.

In school this week, children have been completing a questionnaire to help us understand more about how they feel about their learning and about being in school. We will be able to share our findings with you soon after the holidays. Also, our Y6 football club children took part in a tournament yesterday where they were playing against teams from Milton Road School – they did well, and were very excited to be taking part in a competitive event representing our school!

Wood Green visit: Classes 1-6 have had some time today with a visitor from Wood Green Animal Shelter to help them learn about how pets need to be well looked after, just like us!

Next week:
