<b>Maths tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>	<b>Reading tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Play maths games in the homework area of Education City.</li><li>• Practise times tables on TT Rockstars. Aim for 5-10 minutes a day, if you can.</li><li>• Practise finding fractions of shapes or sets of objects (see resources on eSchools).</li><li>• Practise finding fractions of amounts (see resources on eSchools).</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read a book or listen to a story.</li><li>• Look for our 'Word of the Week' (see eSchools) or words from the spelling tasks in books or texts that you are reading (e.g. stories, on items around your home).</li><li>• Draw a character from a book you are reading. If it is non-fiction, you could draw what you have learned.</li><li>• Read some poems about animals (see eSchools for some examples).</li></ul>
<b>Phonics / Spelling tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>	<b>Writing tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Practise spelling our 'Word of the Week'. Can you find and colour the tricky part?</li><li>• Play spelling games in the homework area of Education City.</li><li>• Practise spelling words with the 'tion' suffix e.g. fraction, station, fiction, direction. (See eSchools).</li><li>• Learn about compound words (eSchools) and try and find some examples in your home e.g. strawberry, football and bedroom. Make a list of the compound words you find or think of.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Write sentences using the 'Word of the Week' or words from the spelling tasks.</li><li>• Practise letter formation or some joined handwriting (see eSchools for handwriting guidance).</li><li>• Draw some African animals e.g. lion, elephant, giraffe, flamingo... and write some adjectives around your picture to describe them (see eSchools for pictures and a video about the different animals).</li><li>• Write a poem about African animals e.g. lion, elephant, giraffe, flamingo (see eSchools for an example and template to follow if you wish).</li></ul>
<b>Other things to try out this week:</b> <b>Theme: Kenya</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Look at a world map and find Kenya. Which other countries can you see?</li><li>• Name the seven continents and five oceans of the world. Can you locate them on a map? (See eSchools for resources about continents and oceans).</li><li>• Research the flag of Kenya. Draw/paint/collage it.</li><li>• Design a flag to represent you or your family.</li></ul>
