'Plants' and 'Living Things and their Habitats'

You may wish to take the time to complete a home learning idea this half term. Here are some possible starting points, or you may have an even better idea for a project.

If you have completed a home learning project, please bring it into school so we can share it with the rest of the class!



Creative – Art / DT etc

- Make a model of a plant, paint a picture of a plant or make a collage using different leaves.
- Use a small box to create a habitat for an animal of your choice. Think about what will need to be in the habitat to provide for the basic needs of your animal.



Creative Writing

- This half term we will be reading *Lila and the Secret of Rain* by David Conway and Jude Daly. You could write your own story about a character who desperately wants certain weather.
- Write a poem about your favourite animal and the habitat they live in.

Science / Research

- Grow your own plant at home and observe how it changes. What will you need to do make sure that your plant is healthy?
- Find out about an animal and the habitat that they live in. How has this animal adapted to the habitat that they live in?

Maths

Grow your own plant at home and measure it as it grows. Remember to start from 0cm when you are using a ruler! Record how tall it is each week in a table. You could even work out how much more it has grown each week by finding the difference.
