Early Years Half Termly Curriculum Information Letter – Autumn Term 2 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

The children have made a fantastic start back at school this week! We have a jam-packed half term of fun planned for them. We hope you have enjoyed seeing pictures of the children's learning on the website so far this year, please keep an eye on the 'News and Events' section so you can stay up to date with what we are getting up to in class. Learning Theme

This half term, our learning theme is 'Light and Dark'. We will be learning about the celebrations of different religions and their similarities and differences, particularly focusing on their use of light. One of the most exciting parts of our topic will be our visit to Audley End, where we will travel by coach to go on an exciting railway journey!
