Task 2: recap over use of formal language and plan invitation to the homecoming party for Beowulf. Task 3: as if you were King Hygalec, write your own party invitation (using your plan from task 2) to the town’s people to celebrate Beowulf’s return. Task 4: contribute to the discussion thread by answering the question ‘which part of the legend do you prefer?’
