This week in school

<u>Languages week:</u> We have really enjoyed celebrating the languages spoken in our school, as well as our links to countries around the world. Thank you also to those of you who have come in this week to read a story in your home language to your child's class.

<u>Today, Day of Welcome:</u> In our assembly this morning, we thought a bit about how we can be a school who is welcoming to newcomers, especially to children who join us as a result of displacement. Our Year 4 classes also watched a webcast this morning by Dina Nayeri, who spoke about her own experiences as a refugee child in the 1980s. The children found her lively personality really inspiring and positive.

Next week in school:

<u>Ongoing - Refugee week:</u> We will be using our assembly times to reflect on the Refugee Week theme of 'Compassion'.

<u>Tuesday, 20th June – Y5 visit to Sutton Hoo:</u> Our Year 5 children will be going on a trip to Sutton Hoo on Tuesday as part of their History work.

<u>Wednesday 21st June – Y5 visit to NCA poetry workshop:</u> Year 5 will be attending a poetry workshop at North Cambridge Academy during the morning. The workshop features Michael Rosen.

<u>Thursday 22nd June – Y2 trip to Hunstanton:</u> On Thursday, Year 2 will visit Hunstanton – this is always one of the most loved school trips of the year!

<u>Friday morning – Year 1 assembly:</u> On Friday 23rd, we are looking forward to a Year 1 assembly, featuring Classes 3 and 4. The assembly will start at 9am, and parents and carers are warmly invited to attend. Come to the side door of the Expressive Arts hall near the school main entrance and we will let you in.

<u>Friday morning – drama performance for Year 5 and 6 classes:</u> We are looking forward to seeing a performance of a very new play 'Find Your Spark', which will be brought to us by Corkscrew Theatre Company.

<u>Friday 23rd June – the Great Get Together:</u> After school on Friday, you are invited to come along to our 'Great Get Together'.
