Maths tasks (aim to do one a day)	Reading tasks (aim to do one a day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Play the counting games set as homework on Education City. Listen to the songs in the Maths project on eSchools. Use the resources on eSchools to practise counting forwards and backwards to 100 (a 100 square will help you!). Could you stick some numbers up to 100 on Duplo or Lego bricks at home and build towers with the numbers in the correct order? Play bingo with your family using the bingo boards on eSchools. Listen to the 'hints and tips' to give you some ideas on how to play! 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Listen to 'Superworm' by Julia Donaldson. Use the finger puppet instructions to make the characters from 'Superworm'. Can you retell the story? You might like to film your version and upload it to eSchools. Read the descriptions of the minibeasts and match them with the picture. You could even write your own clues and send them to your teacher on eSchools. Read 'The Cautious Caterpillar' with a grown up. Have a go at answering the questions on eSchools. Have a go at reading 'All About Worms'. Could you record yourself reading it and send it to your teacher?
Phonics / Spelling tasks (aim to do one a day)	Writing tasks (aim to do one a day)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise reading words with this week's sounds in them. Log on to Education City and play the games set as homework. Practise reading this week's tricky words. You might like to use the blank game template on eSchools to make a simple board game to help you practise reading them. Practise writing this week's tricky words, can you put them in a sentence? This week we're practising spelling words with -tch in them. Have a look at the activities on eSchools and choose one (or more!) to have a go at. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Choose a sentence from the 'Superworm' PowerPoint on eSchools and practise writing it in your best handwriting. Uh oh! Wizard Lizard has stolen all the punctuation marks. Use . ! and ? to punctuate the sentences on eSchools. Can you make a new page for the book in which Superworm helps a different animal? You might like to use the 'Superworm's Next Adventure' resource on eSchools. Create your own insect superhero, e.g. 'Superspider'. Write an adventure for your new superhero, you might like to use the storyboard template on eSchools. Wizard Lizard is an evil villain! Can you think of any other storybook baddies? What do they have in common? Write a list of as many villainous characters as you can and what you notice about them.
Other things to try out this week: Theme: Out and About – minibeasts	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read the minibeasts PowerPoint together. Go on a minibeast hunt, in your garden or while on a walk. Read the PowerPoint about different trees. What is the difference between an evergreen and a deciduous tree? Draw a tree that you can see from your house. Which type of tree is it? Label the parts e.g. trunk, branches etc. Learn about camouflage by playing this caterpillar camouflage game. We are going to start having a weekly PSHE activity linked to keeping our minds happy and healthy. This week we would like you to read the story Everybody Worries. Talk to a grown-up about what you can do if you are worried.
