Welcome back! We are looking forward to getting started on our new topic about the seaside. This is a really interesting topic, which the children thoroughly enjoy. We will also be learning about, growing and observing plants.

<u>Maths</u>

10.6.22

This half term we will be learning to describe position and direction. We will also be working on choosing efficient calculation methods and developing our problem-solving skills. Please continue to support your child in learning their times tables (2x, 5x and 10x and beginning to learn 3x) and particularly with recognising the related division facts. Do encourage your child to use TT Rockstars to help them improve their accuracy and speed recalling times table facts.

Reading

Thank you for continuing to support your child's reading at home. It is important that book bags, reading books and reading diaries are in school every day. Children will continue to bring home books targeted at their current reading level in addition to their own choice of book from our class book stock. Please try and read every day and continue to record books (from school, home or the library) and comments in reading diaries. We love reading your comments and it gives a really good picture of your child as a reader. The recorded reads in your child's diary also help us to win the KS1 reading trophy. This is awarded weekly to the class in which the most children have read at least five times in a week at home. Reading diaries will continue to be checked on a Friday. As we move into the final half term of year 2, we will be focusing on building the children's stamina for reading so that they are able to enjoy texts of increased length.

Spellings

Please continue to practise the common exception words (attached). These are the words you can't phonetically sound out and have to learn off by heart. We will also be working on spelling homophones (e.g. there/their/they're, to/too/two) and consolidating the spelling rules we have learned this year.

<u>PE</u>

PE is on a Thursday and a Friday. We will be doing a lot of PE outside this term so please ensure your child has appropriate footwear in school, or wears trainers to school on PE days. Just a reminder that children are not permitted to wear earrings for PE and long hair should be tied back on PE days.

Transition into KS2

Whilst enjoying our final half term of year 2 together, we will begin to prepare the children for their transition into Key Stage 2. The children will be joining Key Stage 2 for one morning playtime each week and one lunchtime play each week. This will allow them to begin to get to know some of the members of staff and familiarise themselves with the KS2 playground and field areas. We will also take the children on a 'tour' of the Key Stage 2 corridor and visit the Key Stage 2 forest area. There will be an opportunity for parents and carers to have a short meeting with Mrs Rawlins and Mrs Dowdall on site at 2.30pm on Tuesday 5th July.
