

Weekly curriculum provision on eSchools, in line with the latest Government guidance:

- The amount of remote education provided should be, as a minimum:
  - Key Stage 1: 3 hours a day on average across the cohort, with less for younger children
  - Key Stage 2: 4 hours a day
