Message from Mrs Rawlins – 6.10.23

A busy week in school, as usual, following on from a very busy end to last week with our Ofsted inspection! Today, our Year 3 children are visiting Flag Fen archaeological site as part of their History learning for this term.

In our whole-school assembly about Black History Month this morning, we learned about a piece of artwork made by Shawanda Corbett, a young black female artist who uses her artwork to represent the lives of people whose stories may never be told or who may be overlooked due to stereotyping in the media. Also in assembly today, I read out the names of children who have earned their Star award for behaviour and attendance. I read out nearly 250 names, which is an amazingly high number of children behaving beautifully in class and being in school every day!
