Providing release for strategic leadership of sport.	<p>School sport senior manager, PE Curriculum Leaders (KS1 and KS2) continue to work together to improve the overall quality of PE and school sports in our school.</p> <p>Leaders work together to maintain our engagement in the School Games by completing the School Games Mark framework in 2021-2022.</p> <p>Leaders to attend the CSSP Network Meetings to maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of high quality PE.
