1	When they are kind
2	Writing Feel better (if sad) Reading Name writing
3	Let us try first and then help us Practising tricky words on our whiteboards Reading with an adult every week Ticking our work during Maths so we can see which ones to try again Writing words on the board to use in our writing Helping us sound out words
4	Help you learn to read and write Helping you with problems at playtime Correcting what we do wrong in our books Playing games to help us learn - PhonicsPlay etc Helping you correct things with your green pen
5	Help with your work They help if we get stuck Give us work for learning at home (Seesaw) Help with tricky spellings – we can ask a teacher to help / words to practise in our books Books with lines in to help us with writing Next Steps Please Responds Marking books Words on WALT (vocabulary) to help us spell them Reading books with us so we can learn how to read Helping sound out words Giving us books that are the right level Help sort out problems
6	Movement breaks Using my whiteboard on the carpet Using fun Maths songs to learn times tables Chances to practice something together before doing the learning Using a green highlighter to help correct our mistakes when marking Showing us strategies (counting on my fingers) Talking tins Drama/ T4W Finger space sticks Checking feelings Worry box Sticker / bookmark

	<p>Drawing lines on my book for finger spaces Daily mile every day Actions for star words / Maths symbols Help me know where I should be Sound mats / word banks Displays Headphones Voiceometer Calm breathing / mindfulness after break</p>
7	<p>Inspiration! Give us lots of information Tell us what went wrong so we can fix it Help us to edit If we are stuck they will help us by explaining Teachers being kind and answering all my questions They break things down for us They tell us things and give us instructions Please Responds help us to make our work better Next Steps help us with every piece of work – in the future</p>
8	<p>Column method – clear expectations and clarifications Spelling (this was mentioned lots of times) Helping when you get stuck Opportunities to practise learning, eg arithmetic tests Defining words Understanding English Helping you to get to the answer but not telling you the answer</p>
9	<p>Teachers and TAs help us when we're upset If you're stuck with work they will help and support Give us good equipment Give us chances in our learning Give us 'top tips' for learning Teaching different ways/methods to learn Plan fun lessons – creative Care for us Work together Respect our privacy, eg if someone doesn't want to share Sentence starters Class displays First Aid when hurt When feeling sad, my teacher takes me for a walk Keep us safe – hand sanitiser! Talk about our worries Give us resources to help us Listen to us Make sure we have good behaviour in class Borrow books When new make us feel welcome</p>

10	<p>Helping with details Go over things more than once Using examples, pictures and visuals Help when stuck Going to the library with Mrs Haughan Modelling Knowing Next Steps Repeating, recapping Please Responds Practice before then applying</p>
11	<p>Miss Bright and Mrs A give me sentence ideas in English Models are provided in English to help with our writing They don't give me exactly what I should write – they guide me towards my own answer They recommend us books to read If we find something hard, they come round and help us They give us marbles and raffle tickets which encourages us to behave They hear me read most days They give us please responds in our books which we work on In Maths, if we're struggling, they go over and explain in different ways to help with our learning We answer the register with how we are feeling in French which helps us with our French speaking</p>
12	<p>Teach us Recap on the board Clarify meanings Help people who need help – good inputs Very kind / welcoming Make everyone understand it Explaining backwards Progression Seesaw Keep on the board / write on flipchart Times tables sheets</p>
13	<p>Help in lessons In English – the model and examples the teacher does Suggestions on how to make work better and conversations Giving extra time when we need it, especially for Art and English Maths – starters to remember day before Reading quizzes 1:1 reading really helps me Daily reading target Teachers help us choose new books Maths and English books that we were given Arithmetic booster Arithmetic practice each week – helps us remember different methods</p>

	Like the chance to go through Next Steps Pink and green highlighting in English – can see what is good At the end of lessons we can ask questions if we don't understand anything – clear explanations
14	Putting stuff on display (walls and windows) Telling us to read regularly Explaining in all subjects Letting us communicate with partners Resources – place value slider, multiplication square Dictionaries etc
