Dear Parents/Carers

Year 5 - Visit to Wells-Next-the-Sea

As part of our first geography topic in Year 5, 'Coastlines', we have planned a visit to Wells-Next-the-Sea on the North Norfolk coast, which will give the children the opportunity to compare and contrast the features of a small coastal town with those of Cambridge.

The trip is next week, on **Friday 17th September 2021**. We will leave school at **8.45am** (children should come to school for 8.35am) and **return by 5:30pm** (traffic permitting!). The children will need a packed lunch, a drink and suitable clothing for a day out by the seaside, including a waterproof coat. We will be doing quite a lot of walking, so please ensure footwear is appropriate. As part of the day, we will also be having chips and an ice-cream!

The actual cost of the trip works out to £17.00 per child. However, for children who do not receive pupil premium funding, we are asking for a contribution of **£10.00**. Please note that payments need to be made online through PAY360 (previously known as SIMSpay). Do contact Mrs Black in the school office if you have any problems doing this, as we are not able to accept cash payments any more. There is no charge for those children who are entitled to pupil premium funding.

Please complete and return the reply slip by this Friday, 10th September, to your child's class teacher. The children will be bringing home a copy of this letter later today so you do not need to print a copy of the reply slip.
