Zoom update for children in Year 4

We have been incredibly impressed with the learning that has been completed by the children over the past few weeks and would like to express our thanks for your continued help and support. Moving forward, we would like to use Zoom as a tool to further support children with their online learning.

From this week, the following live Zoom sessions will be taking place:

Every Tuesday at 11.30am there will be either a **30 minute Arithmetic** or **Celebration of Writing session**.

Arithmetic (starting 9.2.21)

This 30 minute session will focus on addressing misconceptions from the children's arithmetic assessment which teachers will identify from the arithmetic work sent into eSchools. This session is for children who need additional practice of some of the key skills, it is **not** for children who are already confident.

In this first session we will be focusing on addition of up to 4-digit numbers, the bus stop method for division and finding fractions of an amount. Children need to come prepared with paper and pencil so that we can work together in a supported way.

Celebration of writing (starting 23.2.21)

This 30 minute session will focus on sharing and celebrating the children's writing. There will be a focus for the session which will be communicated to the children via eSchools. General, rather than individual, feedback will be provided during this session.

The sessions are not compulsory however, we feel that they will benefit the children greatly. We hope you agree that these sessions will aim to further support your child with their online learning.

Every Thursday at 2pm: Class catch up

This session will continue to be a chance for the children in Year 4 to catch up and see their classmates.
