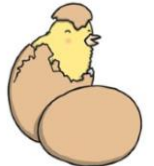
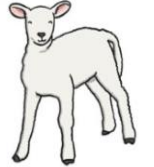
Here are some spring challenges for you to complete. Please send us some photos if you can, we would love to see them after the Easter break.
