Can you use a conjunction to complete each sentence? (See eSchools).</li> <li>Make a poster about staying safe in the sun. What would you need to wear or take out with you on a sunny day?</li> <li>Write about your favourite animal. If you could have it as a pet, what would you do together? What adventures might you have?</li> <li>Write a story about a toy that comes to life. You could base your story on Gorilla or make up a completely new story of your own!</li> </ul>
