Summer 2021 – Home Learning Projects Early Years Foundation Stage Growing / Dinosaurs

You may wish to take the time to complete a project at home this half term. Here are some possible starting points, or you may have an even better idea for a project. Please send a picture of your completed project through seesaw or eSchools to be shared in class.

Dinosaurs

- Draw and label a picture of a dinosaur.
- Make a habitat for your favourite type of dinosaur.
- Visit a 'virtual museum' to view their online collections, e.g. Natural History Museum or The Sedqwick Museum in Cambridge.
- Use the internet to research different dinosaurs or find out about fossils.
- Learn about Mary Anning and what she discovered.
- Visit the library (or use their 'select and collect' service) to find information books about dinosaurs and fossils.
- Make or draw a collage/ painting/ model/ picture of a dinosaur.





- Look at different pictures of your child together and talk about how they have changed and grown.
- Plant your own seeds and support the children with caring for their plants when we send them home.
- Notice and discuss flowers, plants, trees, and other things that grow (for example by discussing how fruits and vegetables grow while you are at the supermarket or looking for different plants and trees at the park).
- Visit the library (or use their 'select and collect' service) to find information books about your child's interests about how plants/ animals grow and change.
- Make or draw a collage/ painting/ model/ picture of something that grows!
