<b>Maths tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>	<b>Reading tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use White Rose Maths resources to practise adding and subtracting money. (See eSchools).</li> </ul> <p>Lesson 1: Find the total. Lesson 2: Find the difference. Lesson 3: Find change. Lesson 4: Two-step problems.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Have a go at answering the arithmetic questions. Remember to use what you know and draw things to help you! (See eSchools).</li> <li>Play maths games in the homework area of Education City.</li> <li>Practise times tables on TT Rockstars. Aim for 5-10 minutes a day, if you can.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read a book or listen to a story (every day if you can).</li> <li>Read the fact files about penguins, sharks and turtles. Answer the questions or discuss them with somebody at home. (See eSchools).</li> <li>Read the animal fact cards and complete the reading comprehension. (See eSchools).</li> <li>Read the words and find them in the 'Under the Sea' word search. (See eSchools).</li> <li>Think about a story that you are reading or listening to at the moment. Tell a grown-up at home what you think is going to happen at the end of the story.</li> </ul>
<b>Spelling / Grammar tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>	<b>Writing tasks (aim to do one a day)</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Practise spelling our 'Words of the Week'.</li> <li>Unscramble the letters to spell the names of some sea creatures. (See eSchools).</li> <li>Practise spelling words in which the 'o' is pronounced 'u' e.g. other, mother, brother.</li> <li>Sentence types – identify and use questions and exclamatory sentences. (See eSchools).</li> <li>Play spelling/grammar games in the homework area of Education City.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write sentences using the 'Words of the Week' or words from the spelling tasks.</li> <li>Write your own fact file for your favourite sea creature.</li> <li>Look at the information about sea life food chains on eSchools. Can you draw and label your own food chain?</li> <li>Create your own word search using sea words. They could be sea animals or things you would find at the seaside! (Template on eSchools)</li> <li>Look at the picture on eSchools of the person on the boat. Write 5 questions about the picture.</li> </ul>
