Year 1

Maths tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Log on to Education City and play the games set as homework.
- Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Play a board game with your family.
- Complete the Spring 6 mental arithmetic test.
- Complete the addition and subtraction end of unit assessment.

Phonics / Spelling tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Practise reading words with this week's sounds in them.
- Practise reading this week's tricky words.
- Play a game on Phonics Play.
- Play a game on Top Marks Phonics.
- Practise writing numbers 1-20 in words, you could use the resource on eSchools.

Reading tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Share a story every day!
- Read a story to a friend or family member, this could be on facetime/ skype/ zoom!
- Write a review of a book you have read, you could use the resource on eSchools.
- Draw a story of one of your favourite characters and send it to your teacher on eSchools.
- See if you can spot this week's tricky words in your books.

Writing tasks (aim to do one a day)

- Write sentences using words with this week's sounds in them.
- Practise writing this week's tricky words, could you put them in sentences?
- Write about each season. What would you wear in each season and what activities would you do in each one? You could use the template on eSchools.
- Keep a weather diary each day this week, you could use the template on eSchools.
- Write a message to send to your teacher on eSchools.
