Providing release for strategic leadership of sport.	<p>School sport senior manager, PE Curriculum Leaders (KS1 and KS2) continued to work together to improve the overall quality of PE and school sports in our school. Leaders worked together to maintain the Bronze Award in 2019/20.</p> <p>Leaders attended the CSSP Network Meetings to maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of high quality PE. This improved subject coordinator monitoring as well as the delivery of high quality PE in our school.</p> <p>PE leaders were released to attend inter-school competition of which there were 7 events attended.</p> <p>Only 1 out of the 7 year groups took part in inter-school competition at Chesterton. The Y4 festival took place but all other festivals were scheduled for the summer term which was affected by the Covid-19 restrictions.</p> <p>Cost: £752 (4 half days + 2 full days) for teacher release</p>
Paying support staff to run/support the running of clubs and competitions	<p>Maintaining the level of adult support enabled a high number of clubs to run for free as well as guaranteeing a high level of pupil participation in both KS1 and KS2.</p> <p>Cost: £1114.31 (cost of TA release to support clubs)</p> <p>Cost: £3867.29 (5 hours a week club admin support)</p>

Employing Sports specialists to provide activities free to all children including children identified as least active.	<p>Kinnerz Coaching provided 20 lunchtime sessions a week divided across the key stages as well as 2x KS2 after school clubs. We also employed a sports coach for weekly support in one of our Y6 PE sessions. Sports coach provision continued throughout lockdown for those children who remained in school as part of the key worker/vulnerable group.</p> <p>Premier Sport provided 2x KS1 afterschool clubs</p> <p>Total Cost: £24,215</p>
Providing free places for pupils in afterschool sports clubs	<p>The number of clubs running in KS1 was maintained, whilst the number of clubs in KS2 was increased in 2019/20 from the previous year.</p> <p>The following clubs ran last year:</p> <p>KS1: Gymnastics, Multisports, Ball skills, Parachute Games, Football, Dance, Sport & Spelling club</p> <p>KS2: Football (Y3&4, Y5&6), Running (Y5&6), Dance (Y5&6), Gym Club (selected children for competition)</p>
2019-20 swimming outcomes for children at the end of KS2.	Due to the disruption caused by Covid-19, final end of year swimming assessments did not take place.
